"My daughter Sybil, take the apartments between mile markers 100 and Tavernier."

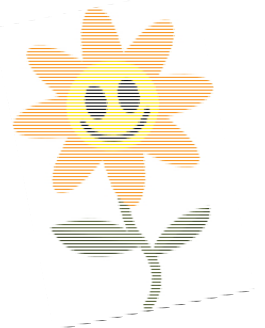
"My son, Jamie, I want you to take the offices over in the Marathon Government Center."

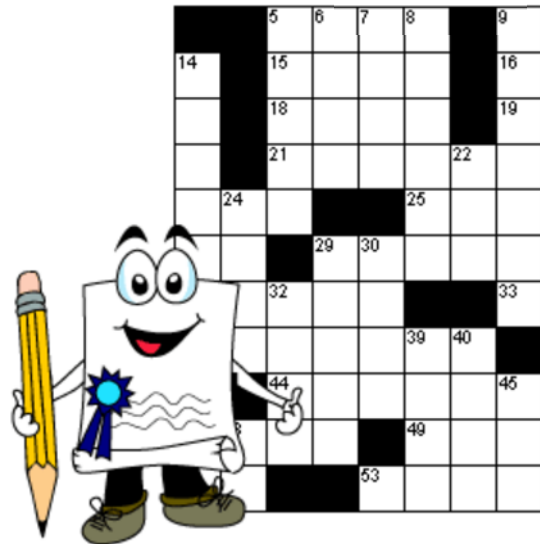

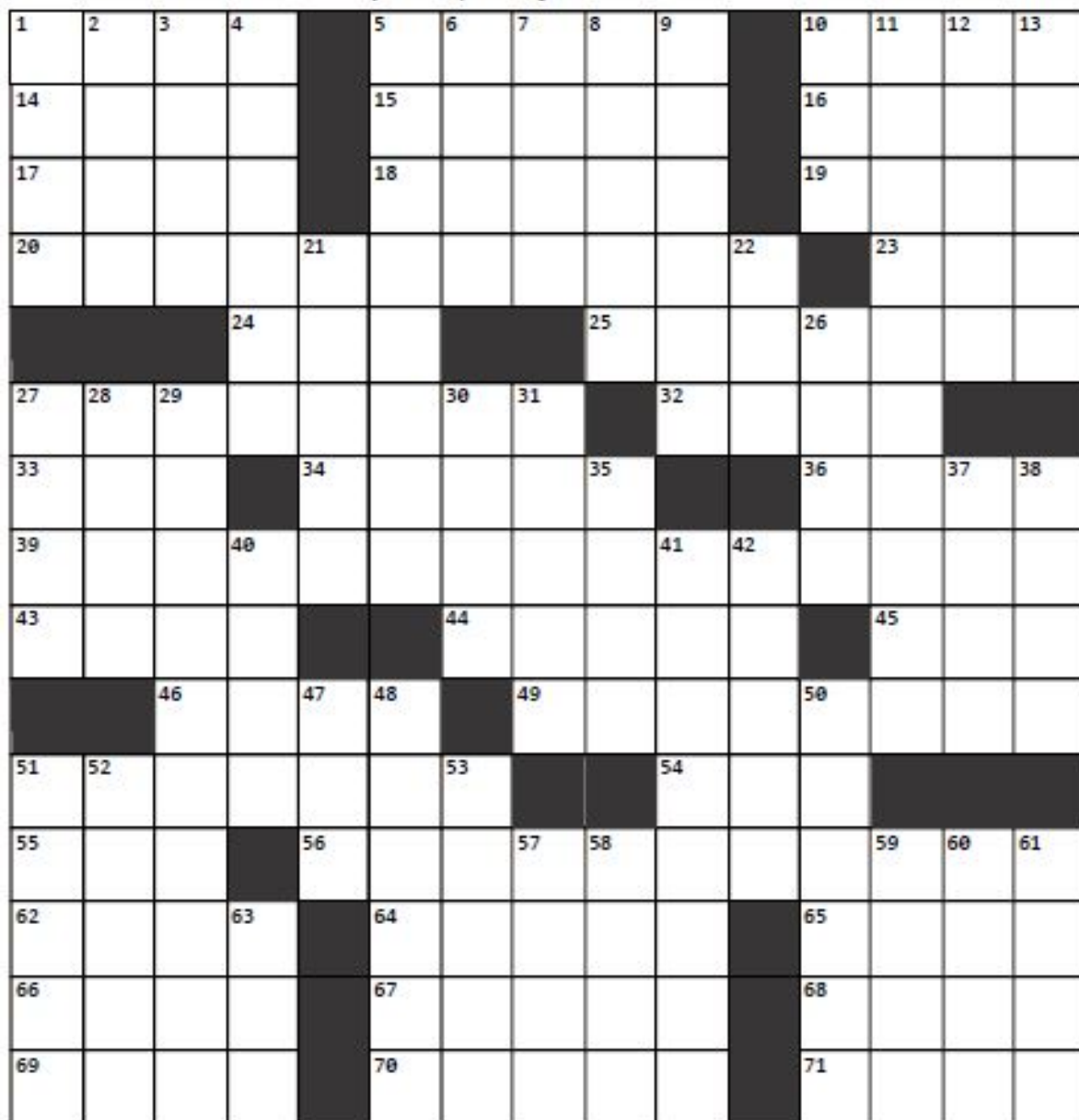
