

RESOLUTION NO. 2-2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF TOMBSTONE,
COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, RE-ESTABLISHING THE NUMBERS OF
VOLUNTEER RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS AND RE-ESTABLISHING THE
SALARY EQUIVALENT FOR VOLUNTEER POLICE RESERVES OFFICERS FOR
THE CITY OF TOMBSTONE**

WHEREAS, the City of Tombstone, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona, has a municipal police department comprised of full-time personnel and volunteer reserve police officers; and

WHEREAS, Section §23-901(e) of the Arizona Revised Statutes provides that the governing body of the City of Tombstone shall establish a salary equivalency for the purpose of workers' compensation premium payments and compensation benefits for volunteer Public Safety Reserve Police Officers.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the salary equivalent for volunteer Public Safety Reserve Police Officers for the City of Tombstone shall be three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) per month or shall be the salary received by officers of the department of public safety for their first month of regular duty as an officer, whichever is higher, for the purpose of computing premium payments and compensation benefits under the Workers' Compensation provision of the Arizona Revised Statutes, to be effective the 9th day of March, 2021; and


FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that the number of volunteer Public Safety Reserve Police Officers eligible for coverage under workers' compensation coverage shall be limited to Twenty-Five (25).
