
IV. PUBLIC HEARING

The Tombstone City Council will hold a public hearing to gather citizens input on the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds. CDBG Funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. Examples of possible uses include the following:

- 1) Public Infrastructure (e.g., water, wastewater, street improvements);
- 2) Community facilities (e.g., parks, health clinics, libraries, senior or youth centers);
- 3) Housing (e.g., owner-occupied or multi-family rehab, utility connections on private property, new housing constructed by a non-profit);

- 4) Public service (e.g., paying the salary of an additional staff person to expand a Head Start program, purchase a van to transport persons with disabilities, equipment and rent to start a new job training program)
