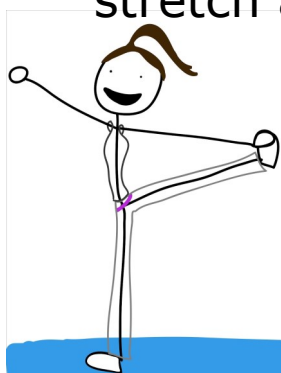
into our air conditioned building and have something to eat! Our generator is a wonderful asset to have for our seniors!
